Deadline: February 14th

If you are the child of an active-duty service member stationed at one of the following installations and you have a 3.0 GPA, you are eligible to apply for the Corvias Foundation Scholarship: Aberdeen Proving Ground, Fort Bragg, Fort Meade, Fort Polk, Fort Riley, Fort Rucker, Fort Sill, Edwards AFB, Eglin AFB, Eielson AFB, Hurlburt Field, McConnell AFB, Seymour Johnson AFB.

The Phoebe Appersen Hearst Scholarship is available to a student who is planning to attend any post-secondary school, including community college or vocational school as well as college/university. Each scholarship is worth \$1,000 and is paid directly to the school that the student will be attending. Although it is not required that the school have a PTA/PTSA unit, the student's application will need to be signed by the president of a school PTA local unit. There is no GPA or testing requirement for this scholarship. An application is on Naviance.

2. Go to the Financial Aid webpage for each college you are applying to and check out institutional scholarships they offer.
3. Log onto www.fastweb.com -a national scholarship search engine with over 1.5 million scholarships!
4. Log onto www.studentscholarships.org-a national scholarship search engine
5. Log into Naviance > Colleges > Scholarships and Money > Scholarship List. There are more scholarships listed on there.
