Students interested in systems engineering, software engineering, math, cyber, IT, electrical engineering, computer engineering, computer science, physics, mechanical engineering, or materials science or engineering relating to IT, communications and electronics-and can apply their studies directly to the Intelligence Community are encouraged to apply. Students must have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale, and 550 SAT Math. Please see Ms. Rizzuto in Guidance for your nomination to apply.

Students who plan to enter a field of study supportive of national defense (i.e., systems engineering, software engineering, math, cyber, information technology, electrical engineering, computer engineering, computer science, physics, mechanical engineering, materials science, or engineering relating to IT, communications and electronics) and can apply their studies directly to the Intelligence Community, homeland security, or national defense objectives. Students must have a GPA of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, and a SAT Math score of at least 650.

Students must be an academically-competitive, well-rounded, graduating high school senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and a Math SAT score of at least 600. Scholarship is \$5,000
