Corvias Our Family Scholarships for Military Families

Deadline: February 14th

If you are the child of an active-duty service member stationed at one of the following installations and you have a 3.0 GPA, you are eligible to apply for the Corvias Foundation Scholarship: Aberdeen Proving Ground, Fort Bragg, Fort Meade, Fort Polk, Fort Riley, Fort Rucker, Fort Sill, Edwards AFB, Eglin AFB, Eielson AFB, Hurlburt Field, McConnell AFB, Seymour Johnson AFB.

Hispanic Scholarship Fund

Deadline: February 15th

To qualify you must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (www.fafsa.ed.gov), be a graduating high school senior, 3.0 GPA, be a U.S. citizen, of Hispanic heritage, legal permanent resident, be granted Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals, have plans to enroll full time in a 2 or 4 year college.

Shelley C. White Memorial Scholarship

Deadline: February 15th

Must be a graduating high school senior attending school in Anne Arundel County who is accepted/enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college, university, or trade school.

Anne Arundel County Council of PTAs Scholarship

Deadline: February 18th

The Anne Arundel County Council of PTAs is pleased to announce that it will once again offer two scholarships for seniors who will be graduating from an Anne Arundel Public High School. The Kenneth Lawson Scholarship is available to any student seeking a course of study in education. The Phoebe Appersen Hearst Scholarship is available to a student who is planning to attend any post-secondary school, including community college or vocational school as well as college/university. Each scholarship is worth \$1,000 and is paid directly to the school that the student will be attending. Although it is not required that the school have a PTA/PTSA unit, the student's application will need to be signed by the president of a school PTA local unit. 3. Log onto www.fastweb.com -a national scholarship search engine with over 1.5 million scholarships!
4. Log into Naviance > Colleges > Scholarships and Money > Scholarship List

5. FAFSA--The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) can be submitted starting October 1, 2019. Visit www.fafsa.gov now to start your application!
