### **American Association of University Women of Anne Arundel County-Women to Women**

**Deadline: March 11th**

The AA County Branch of the American Association of University Women seeks to empower female students through education with their scholarship. The Women to Women awards provides education grants to deserving students. There is no GPA or testing requirement for this scholarship. Application is on Naviance.

**Deadline: March 15th**

**Deadline: March 15th**

To be eligible, you and your parents (if you are a dependent student) must be Maryland residents and currently reside in District 31b. **Deadline: March 20th**

**Deadline: March 20th**

Must be a African American high school graduating senior who is planning to enroll as a full-time student in a four-year STEM degree program. Must have a 3.0 or higher unweighted GPA and a "B" average or higher in Math, Science, and English. Download an application on Naviance.

**Rotary Club of Lake Shore-Severna Park Scholarship**

**Deadline: March 28th**

Applicants must have a strong record of community service and planning to attend a four-year or two-year institution. Also, seniors need to have an unweighted GPA of at least a 3.5 and demonstrate a financial need. Applications are available in the school counseling office or download a copy from Naviance.

**TAAAC Foundation for Educational Excellence Scholarship** **Deadline: March 31st**

To qualify as an applicant, the student must: Have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or a minimum SAT score of 1200 or ACT score of 20; Be attending a College/University in September 2018; Be graduating from an Anne Arundel County Public School; Include at least one letter of recommendation from a member of the Teachers Association of Anne Arundel County. Applications are available in the School Counseling Office.

**Riviera Beach Elementary Scholarship**

**Deadline: April 1st**

Only Northeast High School students who completed at least one academic year at Riviera Beach Elementary school and have been selected to attend a college, university and /or a technical school are eligible for this scholarship. Students must have at least a 2.5 GPA at the end of the first semester of senior year. Students will attend a two or four-year college/ university or technical school. Paper applications are available in the school counseling office or download from Naviance.

4. Log into Naviance > Colleges > Scholarships and Money > Scholarship List
