Applicants must be a well-rounded, graduating high school senior who has overcome adversity or hardship in their personal or family life. Students interested in systems engineering, software engineering, math, cyber, IT, electrical engineering, computer engineering, computer science, physics, mechanical engineering, or materials science or engineering relating to IT, communications and electronics-and can apply their studies directly to the Intelligence Community are encouraged to apply. Students must have a cumulative high school GPA of at least 2.0 on a 4.0 scale, and 550 SAT Math. Please see Ms. Rizzuto in Guidance for your nomination to apply.

**AFCEA Merit Scholarship**

Deadline—December 21st

Students who plan to enter a field of study supportive of national defense (i.e., systems engineering, software engineering, math, cyber, information technology, electrical engineering, computer engineering, computer science, physics, mechanical engineering, materials science, or engineering relating to IT, communications and electronics) and can apply their studies directly to the Intelligence Community, homeland security, or national defense objectives. Students must have a GPA of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, and a SAT Math score of at least 650.

**Bruce and Jessica Morgenstern Community College STEM Scholarship**

Deadline—December 21<sup>st</sup>

Students interested in STEM careers and who have chosen to attend Anne Arundel Community College before continuing their education at a four-year institution. Plan to enter a field of study supportive of national defense (i.e., systems engineering, software engineering, math, cyber, information technology, electrical engineering, computer engineering, computer science, physics, mechanical engineering, or materials science or engineering relating to IT, communications and electronics) and can apply their studies directly to the Intelligence Community, homeland security, or national defense objectives. Students must be an academically-competitive, well-rounded, graduating high school senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and a Math SAT score of at least 600. Scholarship is \$5,000

**Northrop Grumman Engineering Scholars Program**

Deadline: February 5

Northrop Grumman Mission Systems has established a highly competitive scholarship competition for Maryland high school seniors pursuing a degree in engineering at an institution of higher learning. The Northrop Grumman Scholars program will award an \$8,000 scholarship over the course of four years. Candidates need a 3.5 unweighted GPA and SAT score of at least 1150 (new format) or ACT score of 27.

**Scholarships for Scholars**

Deadline: February 8th

Scholarships are awarded to seniors of Anne Arundel County Public Schools. The applicant is required to have achieved the minimum weighted grade point average (3.75) and the minimum SAT score 1650 (old SAT format), 1100 (new SAT format) or ACT composite minimum of 25. There are many areas of study where eligible seniors are able to apply. Most areas of study offer \$6,000 scholarship while some areas are less.

4. Log into Naviance > Colleges > Scholarships and Money > Scholarship List.
