The councils also seek to promote future innovation by awarding scholarships. To qualify a student must be planning to attend a 2 or 4-year college in the fall and be pursuing a stem related study. To be eligible, you and your parents (if you are a dependent student) must be Maryland residents and currently reside in District 31b. 3. Log onto [www.fastweb.com](http://www.fastweb.com) -a national scholarship search engine with over 1.5 million scholarships!
4. Log onto [www.studentscholarships.org-a](http://www.studentscholarships.org-a) national scholarship search engine
5. Log into Naviance > Colleges > Scholarships and Money > Scholarship List. There are more scholarships listed on there.
