



ELETE Senior Mentors Application Process

The **NHS ELETE (Eagles Leading Eagles to Excellence)** is a student leader organization that mentors the 9th grade students by assisting with the “kick-off events” of the school year, including Freshmen Orientation and Back to School Night. Students should complete the entire application and return by Friday, June 14th to be considered an ELETE candidate. This is a leader/mentorship opportunity and students interested will represent Northeast High School for three events during first semester only. This is considerable resume experience and National Honor Society service learning hours are also available.

1. Complete and return the **Student Volunteer Program Application** and attached papers to Ms. Colberg jcolberg@aacps.org. Applications will be accepted starting Monday, May 20th. The deadline for submissions is Friday, June 14th.
2. NHS Selection Committee chooses the **ELETE Senior Mentors during the week of June 17th**. Students selected will be notified by email.
3. **Provide a letter of recommendation** from your school counselor, teacher or supervisor. If your letter of recommendation is not ready by the application deadline, turn in the application on time. The letter of recommendation may be submitted at a later date.
4. **ELETE Onboarding is required for all mentors during the week of August 12th**. You will be notified of the date and time if you are accepted into the program. This is a one-hour orientation session for training purposes.
5. **Be professional** at all times. During mentorship opportunities, ELETE’s agree to wear ELETE t-shirts provided with NHS colors so that parents/students can easily identify student leaders.
