

ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS MOBILE DEVICE USE AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS

The above student will participate in an Anne Arundel County Public Schools (AACPS) program using a mobile device in school. Our goal in implementing the use of these mobile devices is to promote educational opportunities by facilitating resource sharing and innovation. The mobile device will be used to support national, state, and AACPS content standards and goals.

The intent of this AACPS MOBILE DEVICE USE AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS is to ensure that all use of the mobile device is consistent with our stated purpose and that student and parents/guardians are aware of the responsibilities in using the mobile device. Users of the mobile device must agree to the guidelines below in order to participate in the program.

AACPS will provide your child access to a mobile device during the school day when instructionally appropriate. The mobile device will include Internet access through the AACPS' wireless network. All Internet sites, materials, and web-based information will be routed through the AACPS web content filtering system. All applications utilized will be selected and reviewed by AACPS. The mobile device will remain in the school and is not for use outside of the school unless approved for instructional purposes by the designated teacher or administrator.

Student use of technology devices is governed by the guidelines stated in Board Policy JCC, Student Conduct, and Regulation JCC-RAA, *Technology Resource Use by Students*, provided in the *AACPS Student Handbook 2012-2013*. In addition, the student and parent/guardian shall agree to the following:

Students shall

- use only the AACPS-issued mobile device
- utilize the mobile device for the instructional purposes designated by the teacher
- be responsible for the device assigned to them; replacement cost of any damage, loss, or stolen device will be the user's responsibility
- report immediately to the teacher or principal, any damage, loss, or theft
- report any suspected security problem immediately, including inappropriate content
- return the device to the designated teacher at the end of each school day or class period

Students shall not

- use the mobile device to send or receive email unless the teacher provides an approved student email system
- add, modify or delete files, applications, system preferences, or seek to override mobile device security
- tamper with the mobile device, protective cover, or label

The mobile device and its content, like all technology equipment and software in AACPS, is subject to examination and review by AACPS teachers and administrators at any time. Any unauthorized or inappropriate use of the mobile device may result in disciplinary action and/or suspension of mobile device use.

I agree to the guidelines and responsibilities as stated in the ***Student Handbook*** and the AACPS MOBILE DEVICE USE AGREEMENT FOR STUDENTS.
